Arthur Amys called the meeting to order. All board members present. Arthur Amys made a motion to approve the September 12, 2019 regular meeting minutes. Dennis Hill seconded. Motion carried.

Comprehensive Plan Committee – Need to know the timeline for approving the updated plan so they can plan their meeting times accordingly. Mark Liebaert will check to see if we need to move our end or if the county is approving it.

Railroad Crossings, Work is still progressing they are making a mess of the road and we have no way of truly assessing the damages.

Conrad Brown has a request for 2 variances 1 for placing a pole barn within the set back of 65 feet and 1 for a second driveway. Mr. Brown is requesting from recommendation of the zoning board that the Town of Amnicon vacate Brown Rd. The Town Board feels that it will be too costly to vacate the road and is resubmitting the approval of the (2) two variances. The board is still of the opinion that this project will have no adverse effects on the neighbors. Arthur Amys made a motion to approve. Mark Liebaert seconded. Motion carried.

Gary Kane is still working with FEMA. Hopefully we will have funds before the end of the year.

UTV/ATV ordinance Arthur Amys made a motion to support the opening of all Douglas County Highways to their use. Dennis Hill seconded. Motion carried.

Mark Liebaert made a motion to keep the snowplow fees the same as 2018-19. Dennis Hill seconded. Motion carried.

Wisconsin DOT made a request to have access to a piece of property located off the Forest Rd. Arthur Amys made a motion to deny the request, Mark Liebaert seconded. Motion carried.

Mark Liebaert made a motion to set the budget planning meeting for October 28, 2019 @ 7:00 pm. Dennis Hill seconded. Motion carried.

Douglas County has their budget balanced.

Mark Liebaert made a motion to approve the bills, Dennis Hill seconded. Motion carried

Mark Liebaert moved to adjourned, Dennis Hill seconded.
