Arthur Amys called the meeting to order. All board members present. Arthur Amys made a motion to approve the July 8, 2021, regular meeting minutes. Dennis Hill seconded. Motion carried.

Comprehensive Plan Committee – No Report

Old 11 bridge: No New Information

Covid funding: 1<sup>st</sup> half of the money has been received \$66,138.05. If we have had less than 4% growth over the last year, we will probably be able to use this however we wish. Gary Kane will do the calculations.

Hill / Hill fence issue: Dennis Hill recused himself. Ms. Hill sent a letter back with claims that there was debris left on her side of the property. The town will send a letter back requesting that she clarify her intentions. Mrs. Dzikonski is willing to provide the labor if Ms. Hill will pay for the materials. Mrs. Dzikonski said that all the debris that fell from there side will be cleaned up. Mark Liebaert made a motion to send another letter with these requests, Arthur Amys seconded. Motion carried.

Kroll/Dzikonski Fence Issue: The fence viewers determined that both fences meet the requirements for the state statues and deemed this matter closed.

Tyler Kauther requested a zoning change from F-1 to C-1 for a commercial building and billboards on 2 parcels of land AM-002-00312-00, and AM-002-00310-00. There was a discussion Zoning does not want spot zoning and these parcels do not fall into our comprehensive plan. Arthur Amys made a motion to deny, Mark Liebaert seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Seniors: Where complaining about our request to help with minor tasks that we ask of all our renters as in removing the garbage daily and recycling. We have a request for a group of town residents for use of the hall on Thursdays. Mark Liebaert made a motion cut the groups back to 2 days Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Dennis Hill seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Douglas County- Mark Liebaert: Will receive 6,000,000 in Covid funds. The council is trying to put a moratorium on campgrounds until the can establish a better set of rules.

Arthur Amys moved to adjourned, Dennis Hill seconded.
