

Amnicon Regular Board Meeting

June 10, 2021

Arthur Amys called the meeting to order. All board members present except Mark Liebert Arthur Amys made a motion to approve the May 13, 2021, regular meeting minutes. Dennis Hill seconded. Motion carried.

Comprehensive Plan Committee – Brigid presented that the last time the committee met was on Jan 7, 2020, to update our plan we need to create a Commission and Village Powers which requires a special meeting it must be notice 30 days in advance. Arthur Amys moved to have a special town meeting just prior to our regular board meeting on August 12, Meeting will start at 7 pm and regular meeting will start immediately after. Dennis Hill seconded. Motion carried.

Old 11 bridge: Ayres will have an informational meeting at 6 pm on July 8 prior to our regular meeting.

Covid funding has been applied for the town should receive is between \$116,000 and \$120,000.

Hill / Hill fence issue request to send Ms. Tonia Hill another letter with a 45-day response required. Arthur Amys made a motion to send the letter. Dennis Hill seconded. Motion carried.

Arthur Amys made a motion to have the annual road tour on June 14 @ 12:00 pm. Dennis Hill seconded. Motion carried.

Dennis Hill made a motion to approve the renewal of the contract with Michael Schnautz for assessment of properties @ \$ 650 a month for 3 years, which is an increase of \$ 25 a month from previous contract. Arthur Amys seconded. Motion carried.

Arthur Amys made a motion to approve the liquor licenses and sever licenses for:

Gravell Pit Tavern, Liquor, Cigarette and 5 Servers

Middle River Tavern, Liquor, Cigarette and 5 Servers

Riverside Bar & Grill, Liquor, Cigarette and 3 Servers

And allow Gary Kane, Clerk to issue sever licenses though out the remainder of the year as needed.

Dennis Hill seconded. Motion carried.

Tyler Kauther requested a zoning change from A-1 to RR-1 for a campground on the corner of Lacson Rd and Middle River Rd. For 10- 20 campers, request tabled until July meeting.

Discussion on the ATV racetrack that was constructed without prior consent from the town, Chad Johnstad voiced his concerns about the noise pollution from this. Further discussion will be needed at our July meeting. Gary will contact Tessah Belhings at zoning.

Arthur Amys moved to adjourned, Dennis Hill seconded.
